Outcome of the event:

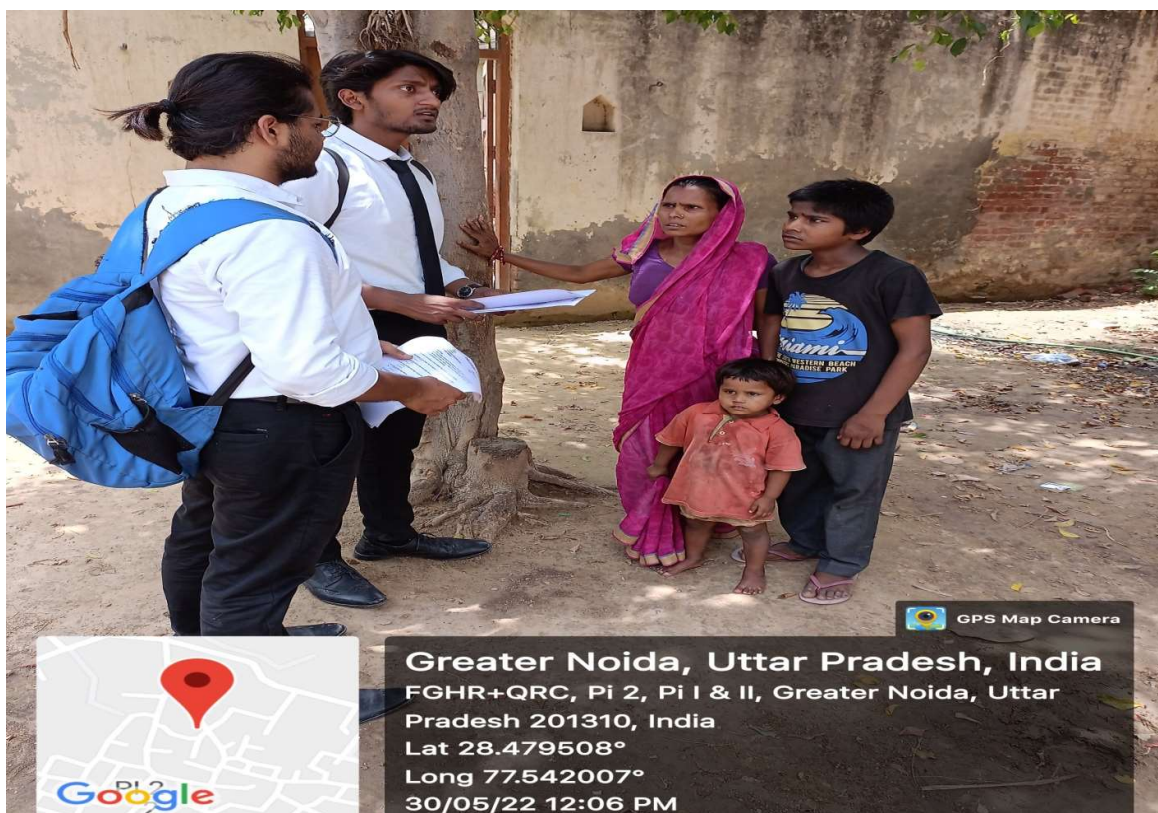
