


Students Feedback



The student feedback was an attempt by the institution to scrutinize the efficacy of syllabus transaction and the overall efficiency of the teaching- learning process. 97.32% percentage of the students strongly agreed to the fact of the syllabus being explained at the beginning of the course. Regarding the capability of the syllabus in meeting global and industrial needs, more than 93% of the respondents were happy. Around 95% of the students were satisfied with the institutional practice of explaining the grading criteria/evaluation scheme of the course by the teachers. More than 98% of the students agreed to the fact that assignments were related to the syllabus of the course. 97.5% of the students agreed about the electives offered in relation to the technological advancements.




